Singer is aiming for star role – in space

LIVERPOOL-born Ruth McCartney, singer/songwriter and step sister of Paul McCartney, has an unusual ambition which she hopes to fulfil next year. In the wake of the artist's recent two-month Russian concert tour in aid of Armenian earthquake victims, Kremlin officials invited her to take part in the 1993 Soviet/MIR space programme, and McCartney's fervent hope is that this might lead her to become the music world's first astronaut and, perhaps, feature in the first rock promo video to be shot somewhere in space. Meanwhile, back on earth, Ruth McCartney will be at MIDEM in person

to promote her debut album, *I Will Always Remember You*, available from Ralph Siegel's Munich-based Jupiter Records/Siegel Music for territories outside the EC. Distribution of the product in Germany and countries covered by Jupiter's existing European deal is via BMG. Jupiter's international director, Helgard von Schenckendorff, told MIDEM News: "We are seeking releases for Ruth McCartney in the rest of the world, especially the US." McCartney is the co-writer of 10 out of the album's 11 cuts, her main partner being the project's producer, Andy Slavik, from Vienna, to whom she was introduced last year by Ralph Siegel.
